RELATED REVITALIZING AFFORDABLE SENIOR HOUSING IN PALO ALTO

Related California has started construction on the renovation of Stevenson House, 120 studio and one-bedroom apartments for low, very low and extremely low-income independent seniors located in a quiet neighborhood of Palo Alto. The renovation will include the retrofitting of buildings, the replacement of plumbing and heating systems, new roofs, and new interior finishes including carpet, flooring, appliances and paint. Other site improvements include new landscaping, replacement of sewer lines and the construction of a new social services center and meeting space. Related was selected by the City of Palo Alto and the County of Santa Clara to lead this development which will allow Stevenson House to continue its mission of providing quality affordable homes to seniors for many years. Completion is expected in May 2016.
